

Chase County Commissioners

April 22, 2025

The regular meeting of the Chase County Commissioners was called to order by Vice-Chairman Kurt Bernhardt at 8:00am on Tuesday, April 22, 2025, in the meeting room of the Chase County Courthouse. Also present were Commissioner Billie Muehlenkamp and County Clerk Wendy Moe. Commissioner Brown was absent. The meeting had been advertised in the Imperial Republican and on the County website. The agenda and open meetings act were posted.

Assistant Highway Superintendent Dick DeWester was present for Open Forum to discuss the water tanker repair needs and to inform the board that he is continuing inquiries about the chemical product application to firm up mag roads. Correspondence, consisting of the annual jail standards report, was reviewed.

Commissioner Muehlenkamp moved to appoint Marissa Smith to the Chase County Community Hospital Board of Trustees for a term of six years, to run through March 31, 2031. Motion seconded by Commissioner Bernhardt. Muehlenkamp – yes; Brown – absent; Bernhardt – yes. Motion carried.

Commissioners directed that the County advertise to seek informal bids for electrical work to be done at the fairgrounds. The bid states; (8) outdoor rated 50-amp power distribution boxes with a 50-amp feed through outlet, (6) 110-volt gecko single outlets, (1) 240-volt 30 amp locking outlet and (8) 50-amp cord connectors. Bids will be opened on May 13, 2025, at 9:00am.

With nobody present for open forum and no further business to come before the Board, Vice-Chairman Bernhardt adjourned the meeting at 8:35am.
