Chase County Commissioner Meeting February 22, 2022

The regular meeting of the Chase County Commissioners was held Tuesday, February 22, 2022. Present were Jacci Brown, Duane Dinnel, Dennis Kunnemann, County Clerk Debra Clark, Deputy County Attorney Rory Roundtree and Highway Superintendent Toney Krajewski.

Notice of the meeting was advertised in the Imperial Republican. An agenda was kept current and available in the office of the county clerk. The agenda and open meeting act are posted.

No one was present for public open forum.

Purchase of graders of the state bid is to be included on the next agenda at 9:00 a.m. Highway Supt. Toney Krajewski said they should still advertise with the same specs as the last purchase with an all-wheel drive option for one grader.

Highway Supt. Toney Krajewski indicated that culverts were considered supplies and did not need to be bid.

Jacci Brown indicated she had been questioned about changing the Champion bridge to culverts. The clerk is to add a period of discussion on the next agenda at 8:30 a.m. for a public opportunity to speak on the issue.

Courthouse cleaning was discussed. The board has decided to advertise for cleaning by contract.

Dennis Kunnemann indicated we need to start thinking about phone bids when the contract with Great Plains ends in July.

Minutes from Imperial Community Center for January and Wauneta Senior Center for January were reviewed.

At 9:00 a.m. bids were opened for county road 346 and 734 improvements, Contract 991-007-21. The original bid option included fibermat material. The alternate option did not and called for milling of the existing surface to a full depth and replacement with a 4" asphalt surface. Schedule A was for 346 South of Wauneta and Schedule B was for 734 West of Champion. Two bids were received. Simon Contractors bid the alternate option for Schedule A at \$2,147,124.50 and Schedule B at \$3,556,531.55 for a total of \$5,703,656.05.

Werner Construction bid the fibermat option for Schedule A at \$1,585,778.00 and Schedule B at \$3,034,885.70 for a total of \$4,620,663.70.

Jack Baker will take the bid sheets with him for review of figures. A summary will be created for the next meeting. A decision will be tabled until that time.

The board listened to a telephonic presentation from FirstNet, a nationwide high-speed wireless broadband network specifically built for public safety. The board questioned the number of devices shown on the quote. No decisions were made. More research is needed.

The commissioner meeting recessed at 10:00 a.m. for a Board of Equalization meeting.

The meeting reconvened at 10:20 a.m. with the board, clerk and county attorney present.

Dennis indicated he would like a joint meeting with the shop foremen before summer. Public hearing on the one-year and six-year road plans was set for March 22nd at 9:00

 At 10:40 a.m. Assessor Bartels and Treasurer Schoenberger joined the meeting concerning the cleaning. Discussion followed.

Clerk was told to delete tabled items except for the tractor buyouts.
