Chase County Commissioners June 10, 2025

The regular meeting of the Chase County Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Jacci Brown at 8:00am on Tuesday, June 10, 2025, in the meeting room of the Chase County Courthouse. Also present were Commissioners Billie Muehlenkamp and Kurt Bernhardt, and County Clerk Wendy Moe. The agenda and open meetings act were posted, meeting had been advertised in the Imperial Republican and on the County Website.

Highway Superintendent Anthony Krajewski joined the meeting for Open Forum, he discussed upcoming projects with the Board, including sealing and patching of Old 6 (estimated \$10,000), sealing joints and cracks south of Wauneta (estimated \$8,000), chip seal/armor coat through Enders main street (estimated \$25-30,000) and to possibly consider a mastic/aggregate repair or to mill and fill with hot mix to fix joints on the lake road south of Enders (estimated \$30,000+).

Kylie Joyce and Mandy Broussard joined the meeting on behalf of Region II Human Services to provide their annual update to the Board and thank them for their continued support.

At 8:30 Commissioners opened bids received for Mower Tractors. Three bids were received, as follows: Titan Machinery – (2) CASE IH PUMA 240 CVX 2WD Tractors for \$264,500 each with a trade in value of \$65,000 for the JD 6135E and \$44,500 for the CASE IH MX110 for a total sale price of \$419,500 after the trade-in or a 5 year, 200 hour lease for \$61,000 annually; 21<sup>st</sup> Century John Deere – JD 6M 200 Cab Tractor for \$225,000 or a 5 year, 300 hour lease for \$28,742.04 annually; Yost Farm Supply – New Holland T7.245 for \$223,000 with no lease option. Discussion, no decision at this time.

At 9:00 Chairman Brown recessed the meeting for Board of Equalization. Meeting reconvened at 9:15 with three Commissioner and County Clerk present.

Scott Fiedler, Kristin Gottula, Jay Blattner and Brian Kemp joined the meeting on behalf of Allo, to present a quote for Managed IT Services.

Commissioner Bernhardt moved to approve the minutes from the May 27, 2025, meeting. Motion seconded by Commissioner Muehlenkamp. Muehlenkamp – yes; Brown – abstain; Bernhardt – yes. Motion carried.

Commissioner Brown moved to approve claims as submitted. Motion seconded by Commissioner Bernhardt. Muehlenkamp – yes; Brown – yes; Bernhardt – yes. Motion carried.

Commissioner Muehlenkamp moved to accept the Withdrawal of Application for the Conditional Use Permit from Sand Draw Solar, LLC. Motion seconded by Commissioner Bernhardt. Muehlenkamp – yes; Brown – yes; Bernhardt – yes. Motion carried.

Sam McNair, Kara Engbrecht and Deaun Carpenter, members of the Chase County Community Hospital Board of Trustees joined the meeting for discussion with Commissioners. Discussion consisted of the hospital's budget for the coming year, Commissioners noted that they would like to see detailed goals from the Hospital Board, specific short, mid and long-term plans working toward those goals. They would like to see the Hospital further explore the possibility and options to operate a pharmacy. Commissioners asked what the recruitment efforts for new Doctors have produced, who oversees recruitment efforts and what that looks like. Commissioners encouraged Hospital Board members to push and ask the hard questions to work toward the future success of the facility.

Commissioner Brown moved to advertise for bids to fill the position of Champion Lake/Mill Groundskeeper, with bids to be open at 9:00am on June 24. Motion seconded by Commissioner Muehlenkamp. Muehlenkamp – yes; Brown – yes; Bernhardt – yes. Motion carried.

Assessor Tori Mueller joined the meeting for the agenda item of GWorks Alternatives. Tori has been in touch with GWorks, due to the 60-day requirement to terminate the contract and GWorks working toward correcting noted concerns, at this time she recommends that no changes be made. She will continue to explore other vendors and be prepared to make a change in a more timely fashion next year, if necessary.

Commissioner Brown moved to approve Resolution 2025-10 to apply for 5311 Transit matching funds to purchase a new lowered floor mini van with ramp. Motion seconded by Commissioner Bernhardt. Muehlenkamp – yes; Brown – yes; Bernhardt – yes. Motion carried.

Commissioners reviewed the NIRMA insurance renewal rates as well as options to increase deductibles to lower premium. The County's annual contribution amount increased by 5.11% to an amount of \$121,924. Commissioner Bernhardt moved to maintain the current deductible and accept the renewal rate as presented. Motion seconded by Commissioner Muehlenkamp. Muehlenkamp - yes; Brown - yes; Bernhardt - yes. Motion carried.

Commissioners returned to discussion of Mower Tractors. Commissioner Bernhardt moved to purchase the two CASE IH PUMA 240 CVX 2WD Tractors from Titan Machinery for a total of \$419,500 after trade-in of the old tractors, with \$200,000 to be paid from the Machinery & Equipment line and the balance to be paid from the Inheritance Fund to be repaid over the next four years. Motion seconded by Commissioner Muehlenkamp. Muehlenkamp yes; Brown - yes; Bernhardt - yes. Motion carried. A resolution for repayment of Inheritance Tax Fund will be drawn up for consideration at the next meeting.

Treasurer Rebecca Bernard joined the meeting for Open Forum to make it a matter of record that Amanda Cross and Janet Tomky will be added as authorized signers for all bank accounts of the Chase County Treasurer's Office.

With no further business to come before the Board, Chairman Brown adjourned the meeting at 11:55am.
